Gender equality in the care economy

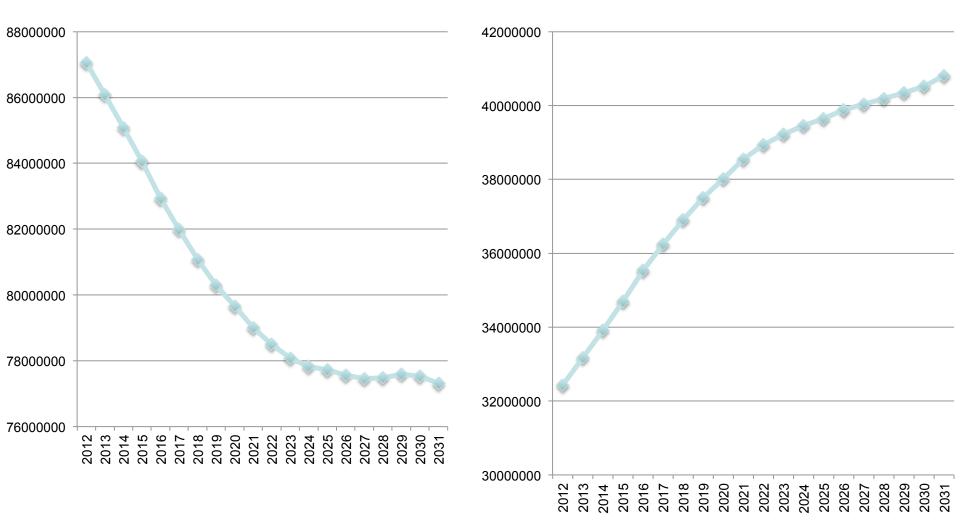
RUSSIA: THREE DEFICIENCIES

- CHILDCARE understand, doing, but we can not
 million unmet demand under 50 billion rubles per year.
 Nursery lost (age 0-2).
- LABOR MARKET first weak sprouts, half measures
 Some laws on distance employment, working mothers.
 Discrimination of parents with small children and women.
- GENDERED CARE ECONOMY not ready, stereotypes
 Female housework is more than male one by 3 times.
 Breadwinner and keeper stereotypes.

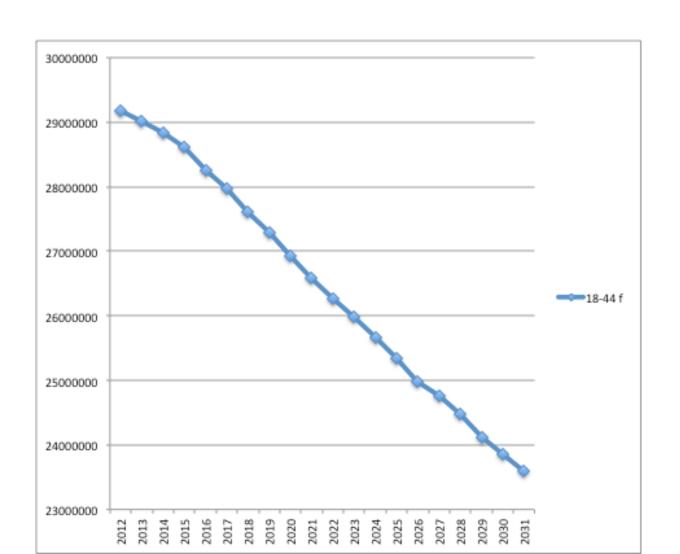
Challenges

- 1. Ageing of population:
- Decreasing of number of birth and working age population
- 2. Ageing of population, Growth of number of older mother (35-44) and their input in fertility:
- Sandwich generation (double care burden)
- 3. Wave of child population (growth and reduction of number of children 0-6):
- Unmet demand of kindergartens today and empty places in future

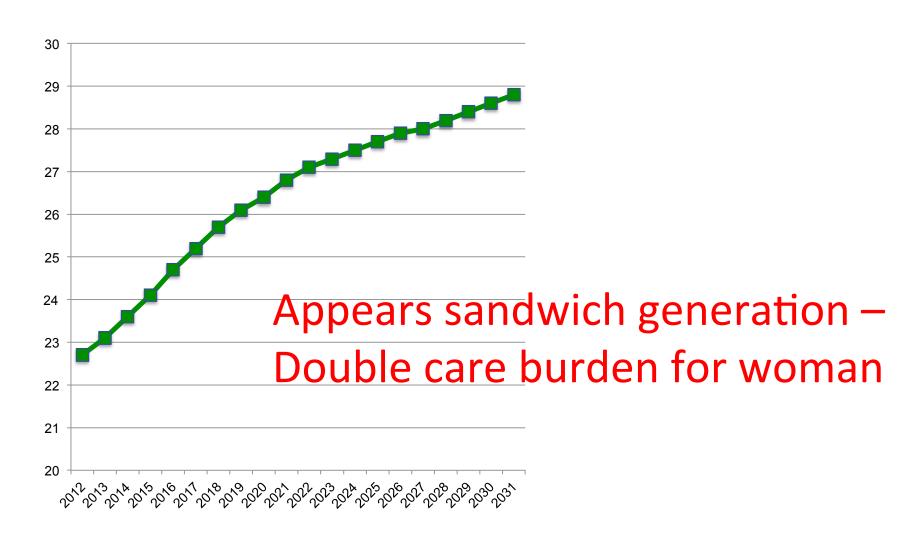
1. Population of working and retirement age (Russia, 2012-2031, -9 mln & +9 mln)



1. Demography and Labor market Russia, 2012-2031, female population 18-44

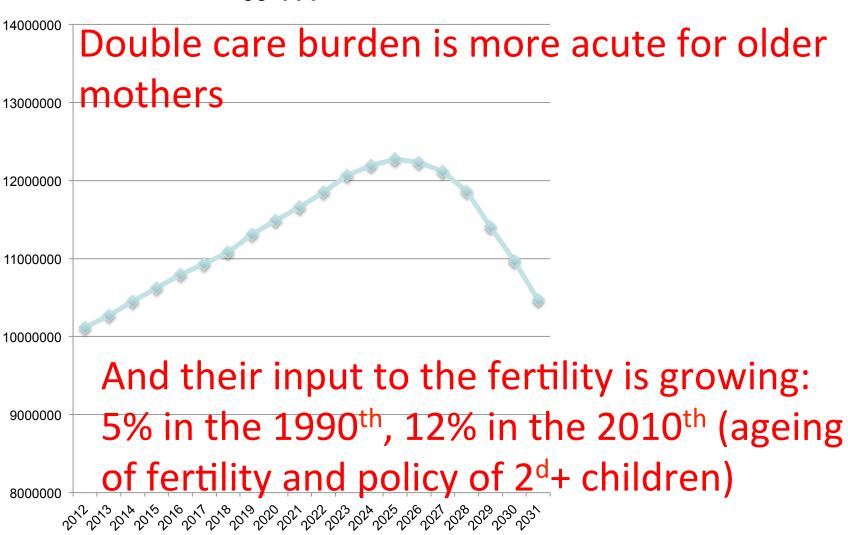


2. Ageing of population (share of 55&60+)

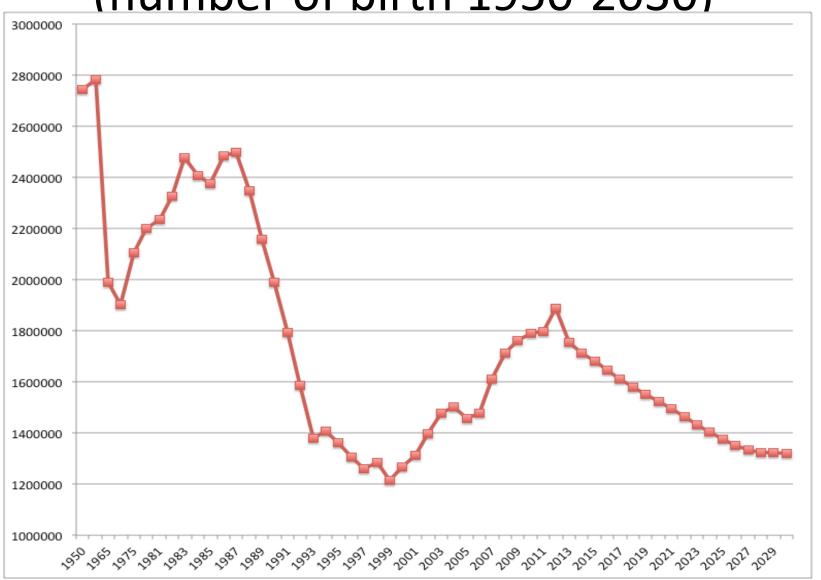


2. Female population (35-44)

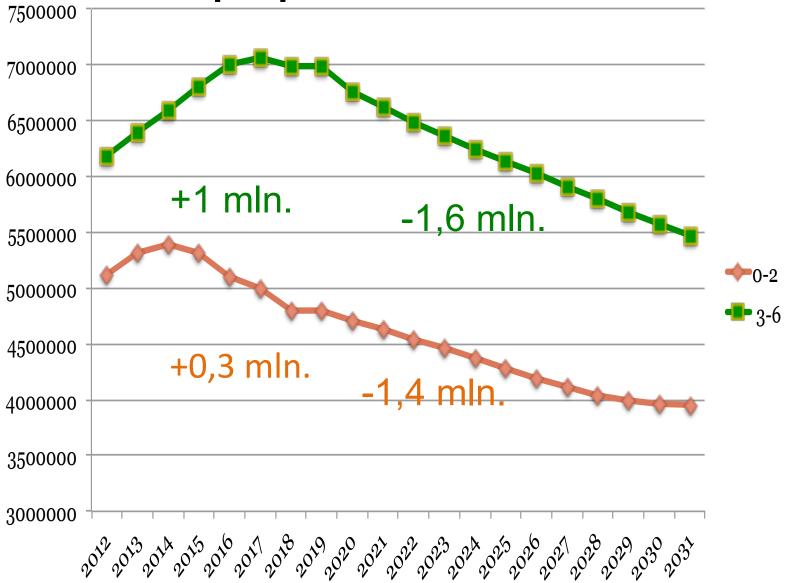
